Trading Price Quotation	One tenth of one cent (\$0.001) per barrel

Minimum Price Fluctuation	One tenth of one cent (\$0.001) per barrel
Last Trading Day	Last Trading Day of the contract month
Floating Price	In respect of daily settlement, the Floating Price will be determined by ICE using price data from a number of sources including spot, forward and derivative markets for both physical and financial products.

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Final Settlement	In respect of final settlement, the Floating Price will be a price in USD and cents per barrel based on the “Mid” quotations appearing in the “Platts Crude Oil Marketwire” under the heading “Mediterranean spot crude assessments (\$/barrel)” subheading “Black Sea” and “Spread vs fwd Dated Brent” for “CPC Blend CIF” for each business day that both are determined during the contract period.
