The purpose of this Circular is to notify Members and their customers that the Exchange will, subject to completion of applicable regulatory processes, cease to admit to trading the below contracts (“the Contracts”):

There is currently no open interest in any of the contract months listed.

The Contracts will be suspended from trading, effective immediately, with the cessation of admission to trading taking place on 31 July 2017. The Exchange Contract Rules and Procedures will be amended accordingly to remove references to these Contracts.


