

## Circular E22/028 Rulebook Amendments

The purpose of this Circular is to advise Members of the following amendments that will be made to the Market Rules and Appendices of ICE Endex Markets B.V. (the “**Rule Book**”) as per Tuesday 6 December 2022:

### Removal of Exchange for Physical (EFP) as Trading Method for EUA Futures

As EFP is not used as a Trading Method for EUA Futures, ICE Endex will remove this Trading Method from the following product specifications in the Rule Book.

- **Appendix A.4.3 ICE Endex EUA Futures**
- **Appendix A.4.4 ICE Endex EUAA Futures**

Furthermore, we will add the same term for *Trading Methods* to the product specification of **Appendix A.4.2 ICE Endex EUA Daily Futures** as this term is currently missing in this Appendix.
