

Coffee Crop 2007/08 (Third Estimate)

Brazil's 2007/08 coffee production is estimate by the Ministry of Agricultures in 32.6 million bags of 60 kilograms, of which 22.5 million bags (69%) of Arabica and 10.1 million bags (31%) of Robusta variety. Compared to previous crop, the reduction is estimate to be of 9.9 million bags (23.3%). Overall reduction is the result of the biannual negative production cycle plus a drought during the blossoming period (March-September) and excessive rain in December and January. The fourth and last estimate for this crop is going to be released by the National Commodities Supply Agency (CONAB) in November and will be available on this page.

Coffee Crop 2007/08 (Second Estimate)

Brazil's 2007/08 coffee production is estimate by the Ministry of Agriculture in 32.1 million bags of 60 kilograms, of which 22.3 million bags (69.5%) of Arabica and 9.8 million bags (30.5%) of Robusta. Compared to previous crop, the reduction is estimate to be of 24.6% (10.4 million bags).
